Intermediate Pet Dog Training classes are 6 weekly 1-hour lessons, then the 7th week is the optional CGC Test. Classes are Monday evenings on the grass area near the Allied Gardens Recreation Center at 5155 Greenbrier Avenue, San Diego, just off Waring Road. There is a Waring Road turnoff from Interstate 8.

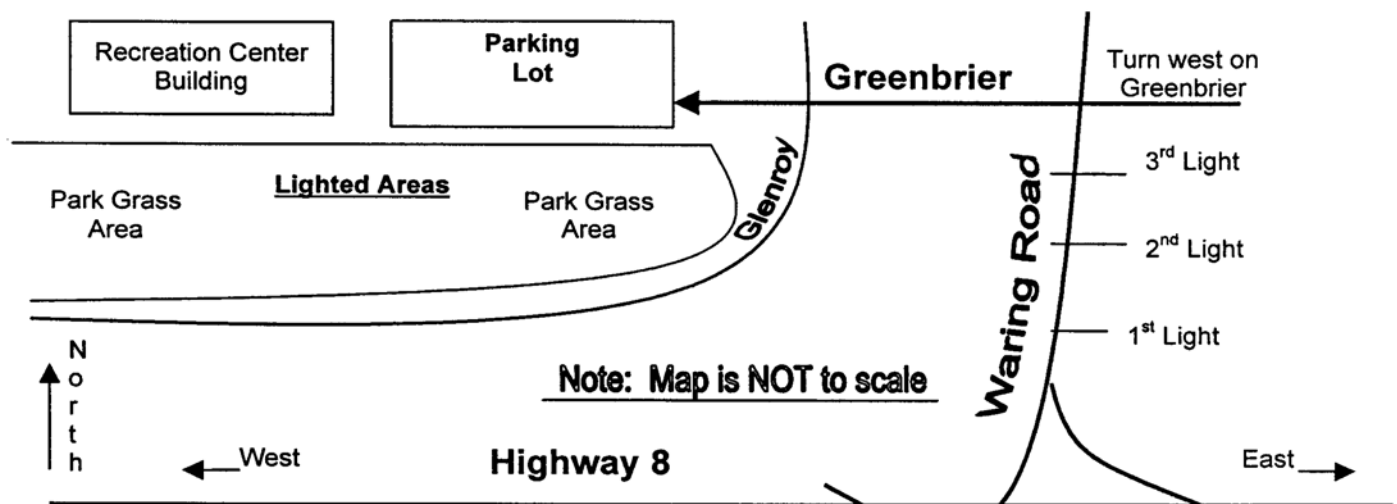
Intermediate Pet Dog Training expands on what was learned in a beginning training class. Most of the lesson behaviors are based on the requirements of the AKC CGC test shown below. You will learn how to teach your dog to pay attention to you and to reward your dog to encourage continued good behavior.

The following information is from the American Kennel Club website, www.americankennelclub.com or www.akc.org.

Welcome to the AKC's Canine Good Citizen (CGC) Program. Started in 1989, the CGC is a certification program that is designed to reward dogs who have good manners at home and in the community. The Canine Good Citizen Program is a two-part program that stresses responsible pet ownership for owners and basic good manners for dogs. All dogs who pass the CGC test may apply for a certificate from the American Kennel Club and as of January 1, 1999, they are automatically recorded in the AKC's Canine Good Citizen Archive.

The purpose of the CGC Program is to ensure that our favorite companion, the dog, can be a respected member of the community. To receive the CGC award, dogs take the 10 item Canine Good Citizen Test. Items on the test include:

| Test 4. Walk Politely on a Loose Leash | Test 9. Calm Reaction or Quick Recovery to Distraction |
| Test 5. Walk Politely through a Crowd on a Loose Leash | Test 10. 3 Minute Supervised Separation from Owner |
