1st Week: Introduction Getting your Dog interested

- Orientation, Frisbee Selection and Throwing Instruction. Safety - .
- Introducing your Dog to the Frisbee: How to do Rollers and Basic Throws.

2nd Week: Getting your dog to catch the disc.

- If you have a long lead (10-15 ft) please bring it with you.
- Learning to put the disc where your dog can catch it.

3rd Week: Learning some new tricks & adding distance.

4th Week: Practice & Help.

- Additional discussion on Southern California competition opportunities.

Disc Dog classes are held on the grass area near Allied Gardens Recreation Center at 5155 Greenbrier Ave., San Diego, just off Waring Road. There is a Waring Road turnoff from Interstate 8.
